



Assembled Unit




- 1. Front camera

- 6. Left camera port


- 7. Bullhorn

Uninstalling Equipment


Step 1 Disconnect the unit from its primary power source.




Step 2 Open the enclosure and disconnect the red and black battery connectors.



Step 3 Separate the lower mounting bracket from the enclosure by removing the nuts on the back of the enclosure. Store the nuts in the provided plastic bag.




Step 4 Carefully remove your TrueLook security solution from the upper mounting bracket by lifting upward. Set unit aside.




Step 5 Uninstall the upper and lower mounting brackets from the pole or wall.

Wall Mounting




Pole Mounting




Disassembling the Unit

Step 1 Disconnect the horn and cameras from the unit by unscrewing the protective caps on the end of the connectors and unplugging the connectors.




Preparation

Step 2 Screw the protective caps that are hanging from the enclosure onto each input.




Preparation

Step 3 Remove the horn and cameras from the unit by loosening the wing nuts off the mounting studs. Store the wing nuts in the provided plastic bag



Step 4 Using a microfiber cloth, dry off all equipment thoroughly to avoid water damage while in transit. Ensure all equipment is completely dry before placing inside the hard case.


Step 5 Place the lens caps onto the Fixed 4K IR cameras.



Packing into Hard Cases


Enclosure

Shipping the Equipment
